

# Airport certification

## Summary

In order to support the latest ICAO requirements for the provision of information about airport certification, it is proposed to add "certification date" and "certification expiration date" in the model.

### Background

The current model has a <u>certifiedICAO</u> attribute that indicates whether the AirportHeliport facility is certified according to the ICAO rules.

#### Rationale for the change

AMDT 35 to Annex 15 requires the publication (in a new section, AD 1.5) of the following information:

- · aerodrome name and ICAO location indicator
- date and if applicable, validity of certification
- · remarks, if any.

To support this requirement, it is proposed to add two new attributes in the model:

- · certificationDate
- certificationExpirationDate

(It has been clarified through direct contact with the ICAO Secretariat that "validity of certification" actually means "expiration date, if applicable").

### Change proposal details

In the AirportHeliport class add two new attributes:

- certificationDate = " The date when the airport certification has been issued by the supervising authority", data type DateType
- certificationExpirationDate = " The date when the airport certification will become invalid.", data type DateType

Insert a new "datatype" class

- DateType = " The value of a calendar date."
